		Can you create a success criteria for making a toy vehicle?	
		Can you design and label a toy vehicle and write a list of items?	
		Can you make a toy vehicle using junk modelling items? (skills - folding, cutting, joining)	
		Can you evaluate your toy vehicle? Can you write a recount of how you made your toy vehicle? (Purpose - to inform. Audience - anyone interested in making their own toy vehicle.)
