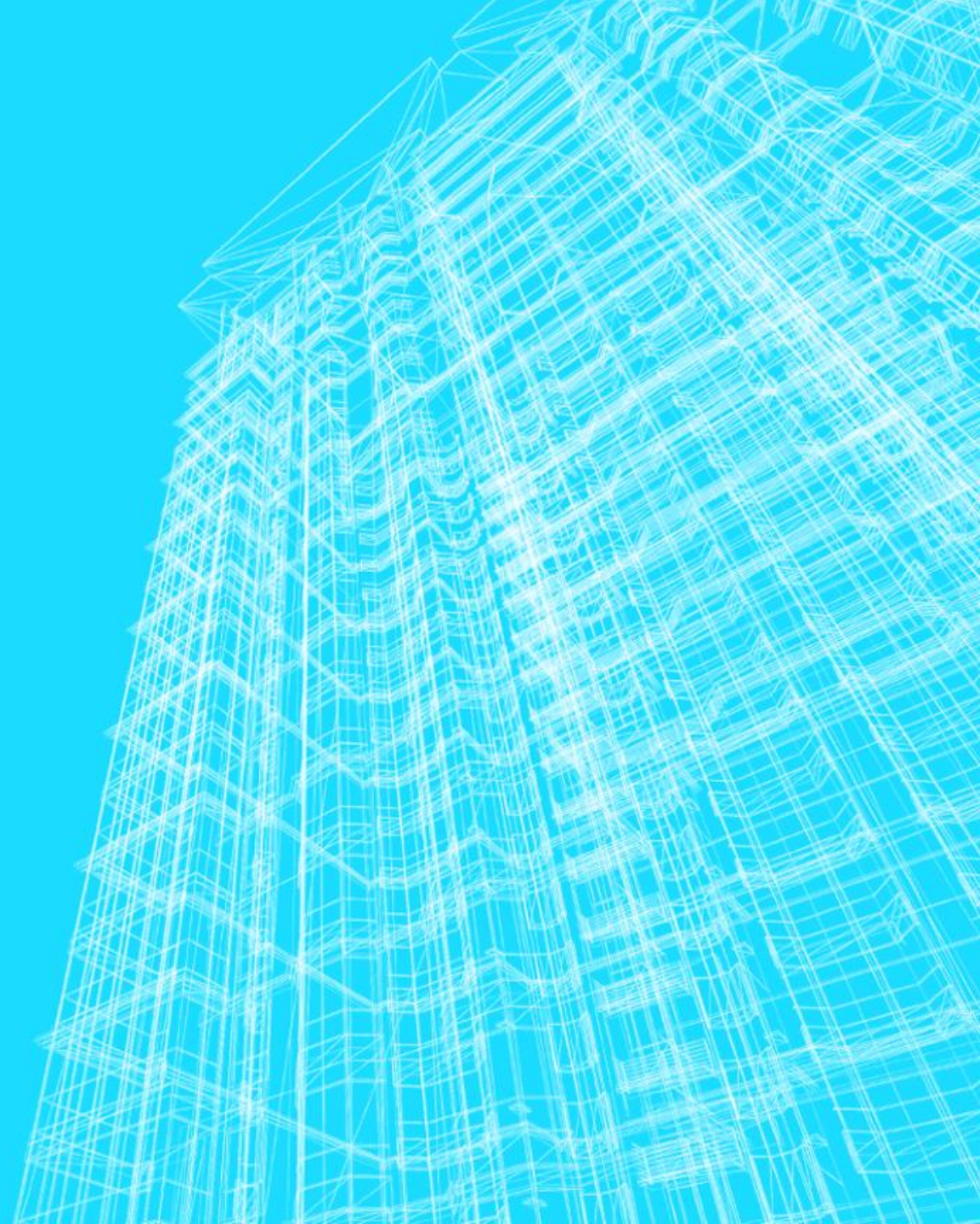

SO, WHAT ARE THE RISKS

- We are going to look at four areas that you need to be aware of.
- These are called the 4 Cs.



THE 4 CS

- Content
- Contact
- Conduct
- Commerce

CONTENT

- **This is what you see and hear online.**
- Some content can be harmful.
- Harmful content includes:
 - Racism
 - Online bullying
 - Over age films and games
 - Fake news
 - Self harm
 - Diets

TOP TIP – Make sure you are looking at reliable and age-appropriate content.

CONTACT

- **This is who you come in to contact with online. It is who you talk to and share things with.**
- Some contacts can be harmful.
- Harmful contacts might:
 - Want to meet you in person.
 - Send you rude or inappropriate messages or pictures.
 - Say unkind or bullying comments.
 - Say hurtful things.

TOP TIP: Only contact people you know in the real world when you are online.



CONDUCT

- **This is how you behave / conduct yourself online.**
- You know the right way to behave in the real world, but sometimes your online behaviour can be inappropriate or might put you at risk.
- Top tips about how to conduct yourself online:
 - Be kind to other people – think about their feelings.
 - Avoid sending lots of annoying requests and messages.
 - Avoid adding other people to chat groups.
 - Always be prepared to share what you are doing online with your adults at home.

TOP TIP – Conduct yourself online in the same way as you would in the real world.

COMMERCE

- **Commerce is a posh way of saying ‘making money’.**
- Lots of companies make millions (or even billions) of pounds online every single year.
- Some companies try to encourage children to spend real money online. They might even try to trick people in to spending their own money.
- Remember that money doesn't grow on trees! It isn't fair to keep asking your grown ups to spend lots of their money online or on apps.
- Consider whether you really need to spend money on a new skin or on virtual currency – like v-bucks for example.
- Always ask a grown-up before spending money.

TOP TIP – be aware that commerce (or making money) is very important to companies. Don't spend lots of money online.
